Stephanie Alexander Kitchen is a Success!

This week a study conducted by the University of Melbourne and Deakin University credited the Kitchen Garden program with creating positive attitude changes in primary school children.

The key findings were:

- A significant increase in children's willingness to try new foods with 39% of children reporting they would try new foods compared to 26%\$ at the start of the program.
- 71% of children in participating schools reported they enjoy cooking, compared with 50% in non participating schools.
- 41% of parents in the survey claimed their children asked them to cook food they had made at school.
- The program was considered by teachers to be particularly effective in engaging non academic learners.
